



RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL POWER UTILITY CONNECTION

These instructions apply to:

- SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCE, DUPLEX, or APARTMENT whose power has been disconnected for more than 12 month.
- COMMERCIAL PROPERTY anytime there is a change of occupancy or use.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED

1. The OWNER/TENANT of the property must hire a licensed electrical contractor to pull a permit in order to complete a safety inspection that must include a list of all necessary repairs OR a notarized letter stating the premises are in safe condition for power.
2. The Contractor must schedule a final electrical inspection or complete repairs and schedule electrical inspections as applicable.
3. Once the City Inspector has approved a final electrical inspection, the Electrical Utilities Department (Customer Service) will be notified of the approval by the Development Services Department.
